MAKING SENSE OF AUTISM

- understanding the four key areas of developmental difference experienced by autistic pupils
- building and promoting positive relationships
- the importance of understanding the individual pupil and to build upon his/her strengths
- supporting pupil access to teaching and learning

GOOD AUTISM PRACTICE

A solid understanding of autism combined with practical strategies and resources for all practitioners working directly with autistic pupils in mainstream and specialist schools.

The training will support participants in:

- understanding the key areas of developmental difference experienced by autistic pupils
- understanding the individual pupil and how to profile their strengths and developmental needs
- understanding the importance of building positive relationships with and around the pupil
- understanding how to adapt the curriculum to meet the needs of the individual pupil
- understanding how to make the environment more accessible to autistic pupils
- developing practical strategies and techniques in promoting effective teaching and learning
